5.2 Construction of the municipal garage – Approval of change orders

WHEREAS that certain plan modifications and specifications must be made in the municipal garage construction project;

WHEREAS that change order 02, prepared by architect Jean Damecour, consists of adding under roof vacuum access hatches and replacing "Z" metal profiles to facilitate installation and ensure metal coating continuity;

WHEREAS that the change order 03, prepared by the architect Jean

Damecour and requested by the engineering firm DWB Consultant, is to change the model of the anti-backflow device, to eliminate a floor drain at the cover of the mechanical shelter, modify one of the shutters, adjust the levels and slopes of the sand pit, modify the electrical circuits for the garage door operators and modify the circuit breaker of a ventilator;

WHEREAS that change order 04, prepared by architect Jean Damecour, consists of making certain modifications to the hardware of the interior doors and altering the exterior color of a garage door;

WHEREAS that the change order 05, prepared by the architect Jean Damecour and requested by the engineering firm DWB Consultant, consists of adding a detail of the construction of the low wall above each of the garage doors and of modifying the beam in BC Fir in order to allow its installation;

CONSEQUENTLY,

And carried that the municipal council approve change orders 02, 03, 04 and 05 as part of the municipal garage construction project and authorize the addition to the construction contract of Groupe Laverdure Construction inc the additional costs for an amount of \$ 2 341.80 plus applicable taxes.
