- Etc.

TIPS

• Rinse the containers to prevent odors and protect workers' health. • Put materials loosely into the bin. They must not be in bags. Do you need more space in your green bin? Compact containers to maximize space.

$\mathbf{\mathbf{S}}$ MATERIAL REFUSED

BLACK BIN

The regulations prohibit putting the following materials in the black bin:

- · Medicines and biomedical waste
- Recyclable materials (e.g., paper and cardboard, plastic containers, glass and metal)
- Hazardous household waste (e.g., paints, batteries, oils, pesticides, propane tanks)
- Construction and demolition materials
- Electrical and electronic appliances
- Green waste (e.g. dead leaves and grass clippings)
- Tires and car batteries

BE GREEN EVERY DAY!

✓ Use reusable containers (bottles and washable dishes).

- Give materials or items a second life by reusing them for other purposes.
- Give items in good condition to organizations (various collection points) or to another person.
- Compost with a home composter or a vermicomposter.
- Herbicycle your grass and leaves.
- Medicines are accepted at pharmacies.

RULES TO BE FOLLOWED

GREEN BIN

Recyclables only. Bring excess to the ecocentre. Green bins containing non-accepted materials will not be emptied and any contents placed outside the bins will not be collected.

BLACK BIN

Household waste only. Black bins containing refused materials will be not emptied and waste outside the bins will not be collected.

ADVICE

The black bin should be considered as the last choice. • The weight of materials placed in the black bin determines the bill to be paid for landfill. • The heavier it is, the higher the collective bill!

WHEN

Place the bins at the roadside the evening before collection.

HOW TO PLACE YOUR BINS

Recycling and waste bins must be placed side by side, with a minimum space of 60 cm around each bin, and the handles and the wheels must point towards the house so that nothing blocks access to the mechanical arms.

IN WINTER

Completely remove snow and ice from the tops and sides of bins to make them easily accessible Bins that are snow covered or difficult to access will not be emptied.

Paint, aerosol, varnishes, solvents, pesticides, cleaning products, engine oil, compact fluorescent light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, propane bottles, batteries, ink cartridges, fire extinguishers, etc.

* These products can also be brought to the HHW depots.

CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, DEMOLITION MATERIALS

Wood, branches, metal, concrete, asphalt shingles, bricks, stone, gypsum, floor coverings (carpet, linoleum, ceramic, etc.), showers, baths, sinks, toilets, etc.

ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONIC DEVICES, COMPUTERS Appliances with halocarbons (refrigerators, freezers, air

conditioners and dehumidifiers), stoves, dishwashers, washing machines, dryers, small appliances and electrical appliances, televisions, videos, radios, computers, peripherals.
