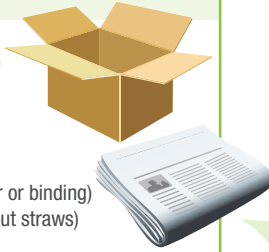
GREEN BIN

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS



CLEAN PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- Newspapers, magazines and flyers
- Sheets of paper and envelopes
- Paper bags
- Cardboard boxes and packaging
- Directories and books (without cover or binding)
- Milk, cream and juice cartons (without straws)



PLASTICS

- All containers and lids bearing the numbers:



- Plastic bags



METAL

- Tins
- Cans
- Aluminum plates
- Coat hangers
- Pipes and pots



GLASS

- All glass bottles and containers, in any color



REFUSED MATERIALS

- Soiled paper or cardboard
- Plastics without a number or with number 6
- Toys
- Paint cans
- Propane tanks, aerosols and fire extinguishers
- Tools
- Windows, mirrors, light bulbs and Pyrex glass
- Food scraps
- Leaves and yard waste
- Etc.

TIPS

- Rinse the containers to prevent odors and protect workers' health.
- Put materials loosely into the bin. They must not be in bags.
- Do you need more space in your green bin? Compact containers to maximize space.

BLACK BIN



REFUSED MATERIALS

It is prohibited to put the following materials in the black bin:

- Medicines and biomedical waste
- Recyclable materials (e.g., paper and cardboard, plastic containers, glass and metal)
- Hazardous household material (e.g., paints, batteries, oils, pesticides, propane tanks)
- Construction and demolition materials
- Electrical and electronic appliances
- Yard waste and leaves (e.g. dead leaves and grass clippings)
- Tires and car batteries

BE GREEN EVERY DAY!

- ✓ Use reusable containers (bottles and washable dishes).
- ✓ Give materials or items a second life by reusing them for other purposes.
- ✓ Give items in good condition to organizations (various collection points) or to another person.
- ✓ Compost with a home composter or a vermicomposter.
- ✓ Recycle your grass and leaves by mulching and leaving them on the ground to naturally fertilize your lawn.
- ✓ Medicines are accepted at pharmacies.

RULES TO BE FOLLOWED

GREEN BIN

Recyclables only. Bring any extra recyclables to the ecocentre. **Green bins containing non-accepted materials will not be emptied and any contents placed outside the bins will not be collected.**

BLACK BIN

Household waste only. **Black bins containing refused materials will not be emptied and waste outside the bins will not be collected.**

ADVICE

- The black bin should be considered as the last choice.
- The weight of materials placed in the black bin determines the bill to be paid for landfill.
- The heavier it is, the higher the collective bill!

WHEN

Place the bins at the roadside the evening before collection.

HOW TO PLACE YOUR BINS

Recycling and waste bins must be placed side by side, **with a minimum space of 60 cm around each bin.** Handles and the wheels must point towards the house so that nothing blocks access to the mechanical arms.

IN WINTER

Completely remove snow and ice from the top and sides of bins to make them easily accessible. **Bins that are covered with snow or difficult to access will not be emptied.**

FREE SERVICE RESERVED TO RESIDENTS OF THE MRC DES LAURENTIDES, UP TO 26 VISITS PER YEAR

-  **HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE (HHW)***
Paint, aerosols, varnishes, solvents, pesticides, cleaning products, engine oil, compact fluorescent light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, propane bottles, batteries, ink cartridges, fire extinguishers, etc.
** These products can also be brought to any municipal HHW depot.*
-  **CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, DEMOLITION MATERIALS**
Wood, branches, metal, concrete, asphalt shingles, bricks, stone, gypsum, floor coverings (carpet, linoleum, ceramic, etc.), showers, baths, sinks, toilets, etc.
-  **ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONIC DEVICES, COMPUTERS**
Appliances with halocarbons (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers), stoves, dishwashers, washing machines, dryers, small appliances and electrical appliances, televisions, videos, radios, computers, peripherals.
-  **FURNITURE**
All furniture (sofas, mattresses, tables, chairs, etc.)
-  **MISCELLANEOUS OBJECTS**
BBQ, lawn mowers, pool covers, swings, etc.
-  **GREEN WASTE**
ONLY ACCEPTED IN THE MONT-TREMBLANT AND SAINTE-AGATHE-DES-MONTS ÉCOCENTRES, IN THE SPRING AND FALL AS WELL AS AT THE RÉGIE INTERMUNICIPALE DES DÉCHETS DE LA ROUGE (RIDR) YEAR ROUND.
Dead leaves, grass, stems and twigs.
-  **RECYCLABLE MATERIAL**
Paper, cardboard, glass, plastic and metal containers.
-  **TIRES AND CAR BATTERIES**
All car and truck tires, without rims, and car batteries.
