### **1. Referred building: 4, Grace Road (Roll number : 1892-20-2109)**

#### Nature of requests:

- Authorize the construction of a garage with an area of 100 m<sup>2</sup>, which is greater than the area of the main residence of 96 m<sup>2</sup> in the case of a private detached garage as prescribed in sections 8.2.2 of Zoning By-law # 112. The garage exceeds the total area of the house by 10%.
