6.1 Adoption – Bylaw #271 modifying the urban plan #110 reducing the land use densities of the PA, RU, VA and FOR affectations and concerning the H-1, H-2 and C-2 uses for a planned development of the territory

WHEREAS a notice of motion was given by Mayor Pascale Blais at the regular Council meeting of May 17, 2022, in accordance with Article 445 of the Municipal Code;

WHEREAS a public meeting was held on June 16, 2022;

WHEREAS in accordance with section 445 of the Quebec Municipal Code, copies of the bylaw 271 are available to the public at this council meeting and are hereby tabled;

WHEREAS the revised urban plan of the municipality, dating from 2002, is no longer adapted in many aspects to the new realities of development on the territory of Arundel, especially since the pandemic, which has generated new significant pressures on real estate development on the territory

WHEREAS the 1st draft of the new revised Land Use and Development Plan (SADT) of the MRC des Laurentides adopted on August 19, 2021, by virtue of its resolution number 2021.08.8461 and

revising the plan dating from June 2000, will introduce a new perspective of planned development on the territory of the MRC including that of Arundel, as well as tools to achieve this, which will be better adapted to the new realities of development of the territory of Arundel;

WHEREAS the 2nd draft of this new SADT as well as its final draft should be adopted at the earliest in the fall of 2022, if not during the year 2023, and that the municipality will then have to modify its urban plan and its urban planning bylaws to make them consistent with the new SADT;

WHEREAS the municipality cannot wait for the adoption of the new SADT to initiate minimal changes, in order to ensure the realization of its major orientation #5 of the 2022 council in terms of development of the territory and preservation of its natural heritage including its landscapes

WHEREAS in the meantime the municipality must acquire basic planning tools for the territory corresponding to its new reality and that it is entitled to modify its Urban Plan under sections 109 and following of the LAU for this purpose

WHEREAS the modification of the density of some of the major land uses of the Arundel Urban Plan would make it possible to safeguard its rights, while awaiting the coming into force of the new final SADT of the Laurentian MRC and then to carry out a thorough and more generalized review of the Urban Plan and all of its urban planning regulations;

WHEREAS council is very concerned about preserving the rural character, the exceptional beauty of its landscapes and the richness of its natural environment and wishes, through this amendment, to avoid urban sprawl, to protect its eco-corridors that cross the territory and to put in place a vision and allow a planned development of the territory of Arundel before it is too late.

WHEREAS minor modifications have been made to draft bylaw 271 in its article 1, paragraph 1.1 which consists of the correction of a typo, as well as the addition of paragraph 4.2.

6.2 Adoption – Interim control bylaw number 272 concerning the sub-categories of use Residential (H-1, H-2, H-3, H-4, H-5, H-6 to H-7) and Commercial (C-11), as well as major projects, integrated projects and certain minor projects on the territory of the municipality of the Township of Arundel

WHEREAS a notice of motion was given by Councillor Simon Laforest at the special council meeting of June 14, 2022, in accordance with section 445 of the Municipal Code

WHEREAS the MRC des Laurentides has initiated the process of modifying its new revised land use and development plan (SADT) by adopting resolution number 2021.08.8461 on August 19, 2021

WHEREAS the municipal council of Arundel has adopted its Major orientations 2022 in order to give itself a global and structured vision of the main issues and orientations to be followed, and of which Orientation no. 5 advocates the preservation of its natural heritage including its landscapes of its territory, implying the respect of the capacity of the environment

WHEREAS the council of the municipality began the process of amending its urban plan on May 17, 2022, by adopting draft bylaw no. 271 amending the urban plan no. 110 reducing the land use densities of the PA, RU, VA and FOR allocations and aimed at the H-1, H-2 and C-2 uses for a planned development of the territory

WHEREAS the municipality is entitled to avail itself of sections 111 and following of the Act respecting land use planning and development R.L.R.Q., c. A-19.1 (LAU) in matters of interim control, from the moment it begins the modification of its urban plan

WHEREAS it is necessary to take time to reflect and establish appropriate planning and development tools for the territory of Arundel, given the new development pressures and the richness and capacity of its environment

WHEREAS if the municipality does not take control measures in the interim of the modification of its urban plan and towards the new scheme and its obligations of concordance, it will be too late to ensure a planning and development of its territory adapted to its orientations and needs

WHEREAS the municipality deems it imperative not to compromise in the short term the achievement of its fundamental objectives in terms of land use planning and sustainable development, by adopting an interim control on residential and commercial uses as well as on major projects, integrated projects and certain minor projects

WHEREAS until the coming into force of the urban plan and the concordance bylaws to take into account the amendment of its urban plan, the council of the municipality of the Township of Arundel is entitled to adopt, pursuant to sections 112.2 and 112.3 LAU, an interim control by-law, for the residential sub-categories of use (H-1, H-2, H-3, H-4, H-5, H-6 to H-7) and for the commercial sub-category of use (C-11), as well as for major projects, integrated projects and certain minor projects on its territory, temporarily prohibiting new land uses, new constructions, demolitions, applications for cadastral operations and lot parcelling, as well as certain land use densities.

8.1 Pavement rehabilitation and treatment of fissures - Chemin de la Montagne - conditional award of contract (call for tenders ARUN2022-05M - file 71.00.26)

WHEREAS the municipality wishes to proceed with the rehabilitation of the roadway and the treatment of fissures on an approximate length of 2,125 linear meters on chemin de la Montagne
