WHEREAS the firm L'Équipe Laurence recommends paying the amount of \$320,695.53 including applicable taxes to the company 9267-7368 Québec inc. (A. Desormeaux Excavation)

WHEREAS this recommendation for payment includes a 5% holdback, i.e. an amount of \$14,680.33 before taxes, applicable to the contractor for a period of one year from September 28, 2022, date of provisional acceptance of the work

THEREFORE, it is proposed by councillor and unanimously resolved by the members present:

TO AUTHORIZE the payment of \$320,695.53 including all applicable taxes to 9267-7368 Québec inc. (A. Desormeaux Excavation) conditional

TO DESIGNATE the municipal building and environment inspector as the officer in charge of the application of by-laws 277 to 279 and 281 and that he be authorized to take legal action and issue statements of offence with respect to them.

TO DESIGNATE the Public Works Team Leader as the officer in charge with respect to By-laws 278 and 279 for the purpose of placing and maintaining adequate signage in compliance with these by-laws, who is authorized to cause any vehicle immobilized or parked in contravention of any of the provisions of these by-laws to be moved and stored in the nearest suitable place at the expense of the owner, as set forth in these by-laws.

10.1 Authorization to Sign the Memorandum of Understanding for the Route des Belles-Histoires

WHEREAS the 2021-2023 cultural development agreement (EDC) between the MRC des Laurentides and the Ministère de la Culture et des Communications

WHEREAS in accordance with the action plan of the EDC adopted by the council of mayors of the MRC des Laurentides under its resolution number 2020.11.8236, a total amount of \$ 35,000 has been set aside for the year 2022 and 2023 to implement an action plan to revitalize the Route des Belles-Histoires (RBH) on the territory of the MRC des Laurentides to promote cultural tourism

WHEREAS each municipality concerned by the project has prioritized actions that they wish to implement to revitalize the Route des Belles-Histoires

WHEREAS a memorandum of understanding relating to the Route des Belles-Histoires has been drafted to this effect and entitled "Revitalizing the Route des Belles-Histoires on the territory of the MRC des Laurentides to promote cultural tourism"

THEREFORE, it is proposed by councillor and unanimously resolved by the members present:

TO AUTHORIZE Mrs. Nicole Trudeau, Director General and Clerk-Treasurer to sign said Memorandum of Understanding for and on behalf of the Municipality of Arundel.
