It is with regret that we have received the letters of resignation of 3 municipal councillors and the Director General/Clerk-Treasurer Mrs. Nicole Trudeau, filled at the council meeting held on Tuesday, April 18th, 2023.

Rest assured that the Municipality and its usual services will continue to operate smoothly.

The position of Director General/Clerk-Treasurer has already been filled by our Assistant Director General *by interim*, Ms. Katia Morin, notary, from the firm JuriFM Inc. She will occupy this position until the vacancy is filled.

Ms. Morin, with her many years of experience in this capacity, has been a consultant for the municipality of Arundel since June 2022, so she is already familiar with our files, thus ensuring municipal stability during this transition period.

During the next 30 days, Ms. Katia Morin, will also be acting as President of the elections for the municipality of Arundel. Ms. Morin will set, in coordination with the Chief Electoral Officer of Québec, the day of the poll, chosen among the Sundays before August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Public notices will be given to this effect to be consulted on our website and municipal bulletin boards. You can also contact Ms. Morin for any questions concerning the by-elections.

In the interval of welcoming the 3 new members of council and the new Director General, the remaining team of councillors Mrs. Tamara Rathwell, Mr. Danny Paré and Richard E. Dubeau, as well as myself, with the help of Ms. Morin, remain dedicated and dynamic in the advancement of files such as the repairs to Chemin de la Rouge, the Town Hall, Grace Road and the municipal garage, to name only a few of the most urgent and time-sensitive projects that aim to ensure quality service to citizens and sound management of municipal funds and infrastructures.

We hope to inform and reassure our citizens as much as possible and to thank them for their trust.
