WHEREAS since then, the Ville de Rivière-Rouge, with the support of local and regional authorities, has continued to intervene with the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux des Laurentides (CISSSL) in response to requests to improve services at the Rivière-Rouge hospital.;

WHEREAS although CISSSL assures us, during meetings with local and regional authorities, that the government has no intention of closing the Rivière-Rouge hospital outright, a proposal for a cliniTHAT project aimed at transforming the hospital into a "clinique" offering services twelve (12) hours a day only, i.e. from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. (hereinafter referred to as the "Clinique Project") is in circulation;

WHEREAS at the same time, CISSSL already seems to be implementing the Clinique project, in that ambulances responding to calls on the Rouge territory are already being diverted to the Mont-Laurier or Sainte-Agathedes-Monts hospitals after 8 p.m., even though Rivière-Rouge is the closest center.

WHEREAS the rerouting of ambulances to more distant hospitals undeniably risks infringing on users' right to life, as they could suffer fatal consequences as a result of transport times that are much longer than they should be;

8.4 Request to reduce speed limit to 70 km/h and install flashing warning lights - section of route 327 (wooded area of Crystal Falls road) -- Ministère des Transports et de Mobilité durable

WHEREAS complaints have been received regarding high, even dangerous, speeds on the 90 km/h section of Crystal Falls Road (Route 327), located mainly between civic addresses #117 and #257 on this road, on the territory of the Municipality of Arundel;

WHEREAS this section of route 327 is characterized by its sinuosity, with a series of curves and drops over a distance of approximately 1.7 kilometers, in a wooded area where traffic visibility is reduced;

WHEREAS the speed of vehicles on this section of Route 327 is very high, and often dangerous, despite the numerous signs indicating recommended speeds of 75km/h and 45km/h above the curves. These recommended speeds are often not respected, nor even the authorized speed limit of 90km/h, thus endangering other road users as well as local residents;

WHEREAS the high number of vehicles and cyclists coming from and going to the Ville de Mont-Tremblant, located less than 10 kilometers from this stretch of road;

WHEREAS this section of Route 327 also serves as a veritable racetrack for thrill-seeking motorists and motorcyclists, thereby further endangering other road users and local residents;

WHEREAS the safety of residents and, in this case, their children is compromised by vehicles travelling at this location, as the speed limit is too high and residents and their children are only visible to road users at the last minute, due to nearby curves;

WHEREAS one of the residences with young children in this area is very close to the Route 327 right-of-way;

WHEREAS the Municipality considers it important to ensure the safety of residents and road users in this sector of route 327, which often gives rise to accidents and the deployment of its public safety services, thereby incurring municipal service costs that could be avoided, in its opinion, if the authorized speed limit were reduced to 70km/h and if measures warning of the danger were put in place upstream of this section by means of light signals (flashing lights) and/or other adapted preventive measures;

2023-08-257 CONSEQUENTLY, it is proposed by councillor Marc Poirier and resolved to:

REQUEST the Ministry of Transport and Drable Mobility:

- **TO REDUCE** the speed limit to 70 km/h on the 90 km/h section of Crystal Falls road (route 327) located mainly between civic addresses #117 and #257 of this road;

- **TO INSTALL** flashing lights to warn drivers of the approach to this sector and/or other appropriate preventive measures.
