WHEREAS the municipality is in discussions to reduce the total amount of the work by \$32,154.00 and that, consequently, the maximum loan can be reduced by the same amount, for a total borrowing of \$494,884.00;

WHEREAS the loan by-law 302-2024 has been approved by the *Ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation* dated June 19, 2024;

WHEREAS that temporary financing in the maximum amount of \$494,884.00 is deemed appropriate;

11.3 Renewal of the accompaniment program – transportation to medical appointments for people aged 65 and over, in partnership with the *Centre d'action bénévole des Laurentides* (CABL)

WHEREAS the municipal council desires to meet the special needs of its many seniors in accordance with its Orientation 3 entitled "Wellness, health and safety" of the *Grandes orientations du conseil 2024*, as well as the objectives of the municipal family policy 2021-2025;

WHEREAS transportation needs of the municipality's seniors, particularly for medical appointments, are often located at great distances and require vehicles and often a driver for both the journey to and from the appointment;

WHEREAS it is appropriate to facilitate access to transportation services for its seniors by setting up a low-cost assistance program for this purpose, in partnership with the *Centre d'action bénévole des Laurentides* (CABL);

WHEREAS the municipality will reimburse CABL 75% of the cost for each kilometer travelled, and that the senior beneficiary will be responsible for 25% of the cost, and that reimbursement will be capped at 200 km;

WHEREAS travel beyond 200 km can be costly, the cost of transportation beyond 200 km will be shared between the municipality and the senior, with both parties paying 50% of the cost;

WHEREAS the municipality also wishes to encourage local volunteering with the *Centre d'action bénévole des Laurentides* (CABL) to make this service even more effective;

WHEREAS it has set up a program to this effect on April 19, 2022, by virtue of its resolution 2022-0083;

WHEREAS this assistance program is a renewal, with modifications, of the program adopted by resolution 2023-01-018;

2024-11-169 IT IS THEREFORE PROPOSED by Councillor Tamara Rathwell and unanimously resolved by those councillors present to:

RENEW at the terms indicated above, the program of assistance for accompaniment-transport for Arundel residents aged 65 and over, to their medical appointments, in effect until December 31, 2025, and that the expenditure be allocated to the budget item, and that the Director general be authorized to sign the documents required for the execution of this resolution;

THAT this expense be allocated to the appropriate budgetary account.

11.4 Financial assistance - CABL

WHEREAS, since 1982, the *Centre d'action bénévole Laurentides* (CABL) has been offering seniors in our region various home support services, such as accompaniment, medical transportation and grocery shopping, meals-on-wheels, healthy meals and community dinners, visits and friendship telephones, psychosocial support and art therapy workshops for caregivers, and various other services for seniors;

WHEREAS one of the organization's main strengths comes from its many active volunteers, who give of their time in the twenty municipalities of the MRC des Laurentides;

WHEREAS financial assistance was issued by the municipality as per resolution 2024-03-046;

2024-11-170 IT IS THEREFORE PROPOSED by Councillor Jonathan Morgan and resolved unanimously by those councillors present to :

AUTHORIZE a donation of \$300 to the *Centre d'action bénévole Laurentides* as part of their 2025 fundraising campaign.
