PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate and drive various municipal vehicles and equipment, with or without specialized attachments (truck, grader, wheel loader, backhoe, etc.)
 - Participate in the maintenance and upgrading of public roads (roads, ditches, shoulders)
 - Carry out winter maintenance operations:
 - Snow removal and sanding of roads
 - Maintenance of the municipal skating rink
 - Thawing of culverts and pipes
 - Ensure general maintenance of municipal buildings
 - Perform any other related duties as required by the immediate supervisor
 - Be available for a variable work schedule (day, evening, night, weekdays and weekends), particularly during the winter season
